Are you interested in law and policy? This public interest law job is a great opportunity to apply your legal skills in public policy and public service.

ABOUT THE JOB

The Office of the Senate President and the Senate Democratic Caucus are seeking highly motivated attorneys for the 2026-27 legislative session. The Assistant Legal Counsel position is a temporary position that will start in either November/December 2026 or January 2027 and will last until June 30, 2027, with the potential for future full-time employment (subject to the availability of full-time positions). All applicants must be licensed or in the process of becoming licensed to practice law in Illinois by the start of the contract. **Those awaiting Illinois Bar results are encouraged to apply.** Attorneys will work on contract in Springfield during the legislative session of the 105th General Assembly.

As a part of the legal team, attorneys in this position work with the members of the Senate Democratic Caucus, policy stakeholders and staff in other departments under the Office of the Senate President.

Attorneys are assigned to several Senate committees and are responsible for conducting policy and legal research, drafting legislation, analyzing legislation, monitoring parliamentary proceedings, drafting legal memoranda, and advising Senate members in negotiations and committee and floor debates. Senate attorneys work in a number of legislative issue areas including, but not limited to: civil law, civil rights, criminal law, family law, healthcare regulation, housing, energy, environmental, privacy, constitutional rights, election law, employment/labor regulation.

Successful candidates must be able to work well in a fast-paced environment and must possess excellent writing skills, outstanding communication skills, and the ability to exercise independent judgment. This position is a great opportunity to gain invaluable insight into the legislative process, gain skills in legal research and negotiation, and play an integral part in state policymaking on a variety of topics.

COMPENSATION

Contract attorneys are paid at a rate of \$70,000 per year. For those not living in Central Illinois, a per diem is provided to cover the costs of maintaining a residence near the Capitol and reimbursement for the cost of travel back home from Springfield most weekends. The contract also includes health insurance reimbursements.

INTERESTED?

The hiring process will happen on a rolling basis, with virtual interviews to be scheduled at a time to be determined by the parties. Early application is strongly encouraged. The application deadline is 4 p.m. (CST), September 25, 2026. Applicants should send by mail or email:

- two professional references, and
- a short writing sample (no more than 3 pages).
