202 SUBPART E: LICENSING QUALIFICATIONS

204 Section 1900.520 Minimum Qualifications

- 206 a) An applicant for a master sports wagering license, supplier license, management
 207 service provider license, or tier 2 official league data supplier license is not
 208 eligible for the respective license if the applicant, any owner of the applicant, any
 209 key person of the applicant, or any employee who participates in the management
 210 of sports wagering operations authorized under the Act:
- 212 1) Has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this State, any other
 213 state, or the United States;

- 215 2) Has been convicted of any violation of Article 28 of the Criminal Code of
216 1961 or the Criminal Code of 2012 [720 ILCS 5], or substantially similar
217 laws of any other jurisdiction; or

- 219 3) Has submitted an application for a license under the Act, or any other
220 documentation, to the Board that contains false information.

- 222 b) In addition to the requirements of subsection (a), an online sports wagering
223 operator applying to the Board for a master sports wagering license under Section
224 25-45 of the Act is not eligible for licensure if the applicant, any owner of the
225 applicant, any key person of the applicant, or any employee who participates in
226 the management or operation of sports wagering operations authorized under the
227 Act has been convicted of a crime involving dishonesty or moral turpitude.

- 229 c) A person applying to the Board for an occupational license under Section 25-
230 15(e) of the Act must be an employee of a master sports wagering or management
231 services provider licensee, and must meet the same requirements an applicant for
232 an occupational licensee must meet under Section 9 of the Illinois Gaming Act
233 [230 ILCS 10]. For the purposes of applicability of Section 9(a)(2) of the Illinois
234 Gambling Act, all individuals required to hold a Level 1 or Level 2 occupational
235 license are considered to be performing functions involved in gaming by patrons.
