3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment  
4 No. 3, as follows:

5 on page 2, lines 22 and 23, by replacing "and cumulative grade  
6 point average" with "cumulative grade point average, and high  
7 school"; and

8 on page 3, line 8, by replacing "Beginning with the 2027-2028  
9 academic year, the" with "The"; and

10 on page 3, line 25, after "Commission", by inserting ","; and

11 on page 4, line 1, after "Board", by inserting ","; and

12 on page 4, line 2, by replacing "shall" with "may"; and

1 on page 4, line 5, by replacing "Board of Higher Education. The  
2 Board of Higher Education" with "Board of Higher Education as  
3 needed for the administration of the program. The Board of  
4 Higher Education, the Illinois Student Assistance  
5 Commission,"; and

6 on page 4, line 9, after "university", by inserting "and  
7 community college"; and

8 on page 4, line 15, after "and", by inserting "may"; and

9 by replacing line 25 on page 7 through line 3 on page 8 with  
10 the following:

11 "(1) If informed consent to the redisclosure of a  
12 student's direct admissions information is provided pursuant  
13 to subsection (b-5) of Section 10-20.5a or subparagraph (b-5)  
14 of paragraph 16 of Section 34-18 of the School Code, the  
15 Illinois Student Assistance Commission may, as needed for the  
16 administration of the direct admission program, redisclose the  
17 student's direct admissions information to the Board of Higher  
18 Education, the Illinois Community College Board, public  
19 universities for which the student qualifies under the direct  
20 admission program, the University of Illinois at  
21 Urbana-Champaign and the University of Illinois at Chicago if  
22 the student qualifies under Section 20, the community college  
23 district where the student resides, and, if applicable, a

1 third party that operates a statewide student application  
2 portal. Direct admissions information may not be redisclosed  
3 to other entities or individuals unless informed consent to  
4 the redisclosure is provided pursuant to subsection (b-5) of  
5 Section 10-20.5a or subparagraph (b-5) of paragraph 16 of  
6 Section 34-18 of the School Code."; and

7 on page 8, line 8, by replacing "Beginning with the 2027-2028  
8 academic year, the" with "The"; and

9 on page 8, lines 13 and 14, by replacing "an access and  
10 outreach campaign" with "a process"; and

11 on page 8, line 15, by deleting "juniors and"; and

12 on page 9, line 14, after "Education", by inserting "as needed  
13 for the administration of this Section"; and

14 on page 10, by replacing lines 17 through 19 with the  
15 following:

16 "qualified under Section 20, those who"; and

17 on page 17, lines 18 and 19, by replacing "and cumulative grade  
18 point average" with "cumulative grade point average, and high  
19 school"; and

1 on page 19, line 13, by replacing "request" with "consent";

4 following:

5 "Student Assistance Commission.

6 The Illinois Student Assistance Commission shall provide  
7 template opt-in language to those school districts maintaining  
8 grades 10 through 12, which shall be made available on the  
9 Commission's website no later than June 30, 2025. The template  
10 opt-in language shall specify that if the student or the  
11 student's parent or guardian consents, the student's direct  
12 admissions information will be sent to the Illinois Student  
13 Assistance Commission and the direct admissions information  
14 may, as needed for the administration of the direct admission  
15 program under the Public University Direct Admission Program  
16 Act, be redisclosed to the Board of Higher Education, the  
17 Illinois Community College Board, public universities for  
18 which the student qualifies under the direct admission  
19 program, the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and  
20 the University of Illinois at Chicago if the student qualifies  
21 under Section 20 of the Public University Direct Admission  
22 Program Act, the community college district where the student  
23 resides, and, if applicable, a third party that operates a  
24 statewide student application portal. The template opt-in  
25 language shall also specify that direct admissions information

1 may not be redisclosed to any other individual or entity  
2 unless the opt-in language notifies the student or the  
3 student's parent or guardian of such redisclosure and the  
4 student or the student's parent or guardian consents to the  
5 redisclosure.

18 The Illinois Student Assistance Commission shall provide  
19 template opt-in language to those school districts maintaining  
20 grades 10 through 12, which shall be made available on the  
21 Commission's website no later than June 30, 2025. The template  
22 opt-in language shall specify that if the student or the

2 direct admissions information will be sent to the Illinois  
3 Student Assistance Commission and the direct admissions  
4 information may, as needed for the administration of the  
5 direct admission program under the Public University Direct  
6 Admission Program Act, be redisclosed to the Board of Higher  
7 Education, the Illinois Community College Board, public  
8 universities for which the student qualifies under the direct  
9 admission program, the University of Illinois at  
10 Urbana-Champaign and the University of Illinois at Chicago if  
11 the student qualifies under Section 20 of the Public  
12 University Direct Admission Program Act, the community college  
13 district where the student resides, and, if applicable, a  
14 third party that operates a statewide student application  
15 portal. The template opt-in language shall also specify that  
16 direct admissions information may not be redisclosed to any  
17 other individual or entity unless the opt-in language notifies
